To Whom It May Concern:

As Chief Engineer for a 34 story commercial high-rise property in the financial district of downtown San Diego, I am writing to tell you about my experience with water leaks in my building, the kind of disruption it creates and what can happen when a water detection system is installed to minimize water related damage.


